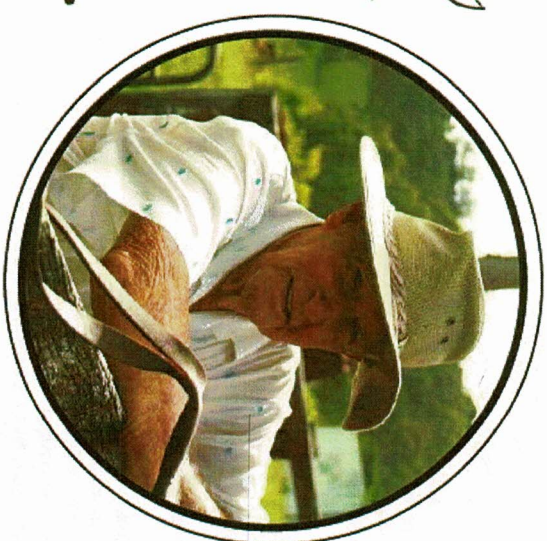

First Reading: Isaiah 25: 6A, 7 – 9

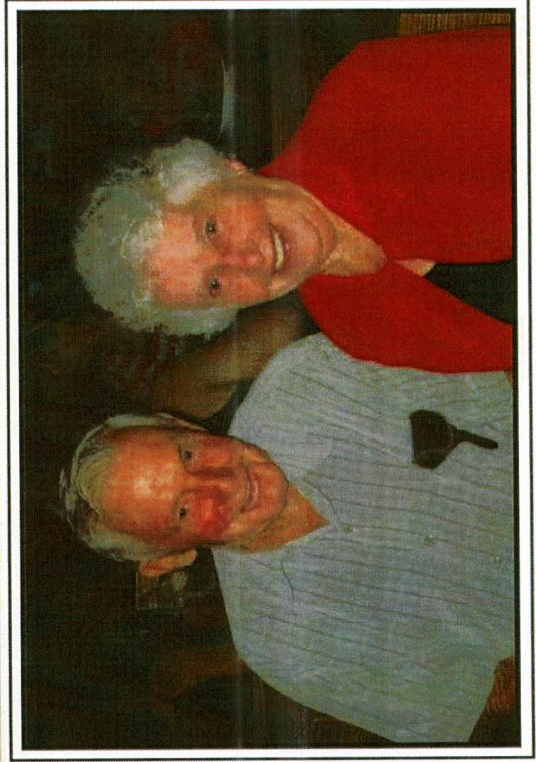
A reading from the prophet Isaiah.
