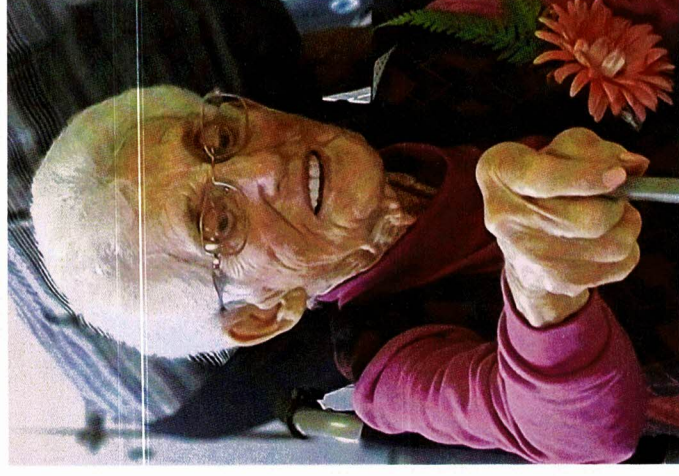



May you always walk in sunshine,
