Scripture Reading – From The Gospel of John, Chapter 11.

*John 11:1. Now a man named Lazarus was sick. He was from Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha.....³ So the sisters sent word to Jesus, "Lord, the one you love is sick."¹⁷ On his arrival, Jesus found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days.....²¹ "Lord," Martha said to Jesus, "if you had been here, my brother would not have died."²² But I know that even now God will give you whatever you ask."²³ Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again."²⁴ Martha answered, "I know he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day."²⁵ Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies;²⁶ and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. **Do you believe this?**"⁴⁰ Then Jesus said, "Did I not tell you that if you believed, you would see the glory of God?"⁴¹ So they took away the stone.
