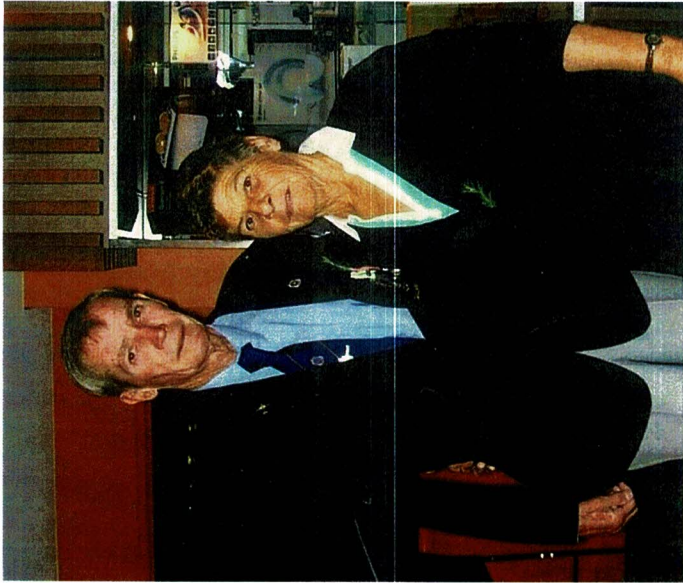
Lord's Prayer:

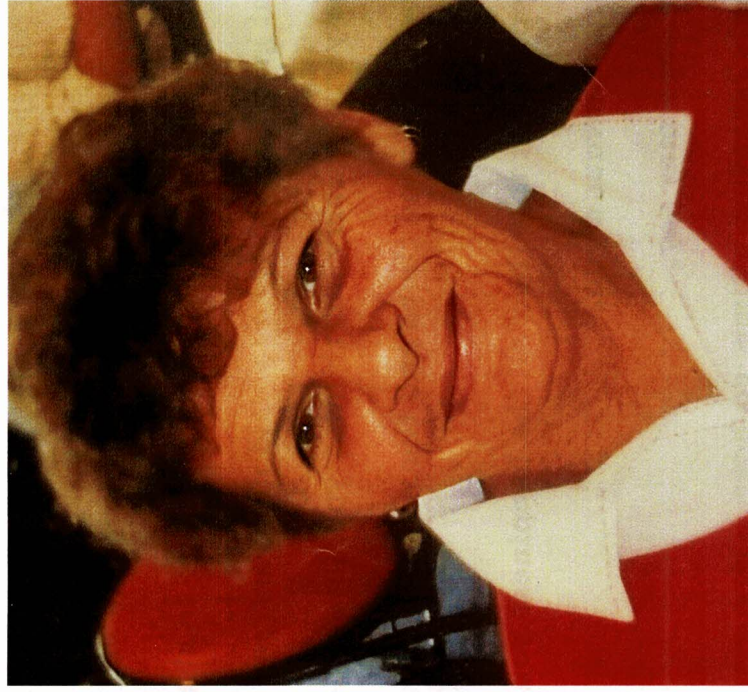
